

Session Title: Choosing the Right Curriculum for Our Site

Session Description:

This informative virtual session is designed to support single curriculum selection for use across multiple sites. Organizational leaders are selecting and aligning the most effective curriculum for their participants from multiple communities with specific outcomes in mind. Participants will explore how to match program goals, youth needs, and their chosen SEL outcomes with appropriate curriculum models.

Through guided discussion, organizational leaders will discuss the key elements associated with the “why” of one curriculum. The challenge is clear: one curriculum, what is at stake if we are misaligned, and the importance of decision authority (who decides) when consensus isn’t reached.

By the end of the session, participants will leave with greater clarity on the importance of having system-wide goals, evaluating curriculum options to establish a shared criteria, and how to establish the path to a finalist and their decision-making path.
